Primary Function:

The primary function of a sanitation associate is to execute sanitation standard operating procedures in accordance with the master sanitation schedule and all applicable regulatory requirements to ensure food storage and processing environments are clean and sanitized adequately to prevent the adulteration of food.

- Works with sanitation leadership on improving daily sanitation processes, resulting in thorough cleaning of equipment and facilities in a safe manner
- Ensures clean facilities via effective hygiene practices through the use of appropriate chemicals and methods.
